2 (b) In addition to any other penalties provided by law, a judge may impose the following
3 penalties for speeding:

4 (1) For speeds up to and including fifteen miles per hour (15 mph) over the posted speed
5 limit on public highways, a fine as provided for in subsection (a) for the first offense, ten dollars
6 (\$10.00) per mile for each mile in excess of the speed limit for the second offense if within
7 twelve (12) months of the first offense, and fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per mile for each mile in
8 excess of the speed limit for the third and any subsequent offense if within twelve (12) months of
9 the first offense. In addition, the license may be suspended up to thirty (30) days.

10 (2) For speeds in excess of fifteen miles per hour (15 mph) over the posted speed limit on
11 public highways, a mandatory fine of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each mile over the speed limit for
12 the first offense, fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per mile for each mile in excess of the speed limit for the
13 second offense if within twelve (12) months of the first offense, and twenty dollars (\$20.00) per
14 mile for each mile in excess of the speed limit for the third and subsequent offense if within
15 twelve (12) months of the first offense. In addition, the license may be suspended up to sixty (60)
16 days.

17 (c) Any person charged with a violation who pays the fine administratively pursuant to
18 chapter 8.2 of title 8 is not subject to any additional costs or assessments, including, but not
19 limited to, the hearing fee established in section 818-4 or an assessment for substance abuse
20 prevention.

21 SECTION 2. Chapter 31-45 of the General Laws entitled "Noise Limits for Motor
22 Vehicles" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

23 **31-45-6. Public nuisance declaration. – Overpowered motor vehicle music**
24 **amplification systems which produce sounds which annoy and disturb persons outside of the**
25 **enclosure of a motor vehicle and which can be heard in residences and in businesses within one**
26 **hundred feet (100') of open air of the location of such systems, are hereby declared to be a public**
27 **nuisance and a health hazard.**

28 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION
BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
OF
AN ACT
RELATING TO NOISE LIMITS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES

1 This act would prohibit motor vehicle sound systems which produce excessive noise and
2 declares over powered motor vehicle sound systems to be a public nuisance, subject to
3 regulations.

4 This act would take effect upon passage.
